Eligibility criteria

To be eligible for seed funding, the delegate must:

1. Be affiliated with an institution that can manage the seed funding grant on their behalf.

29th -30th July 2025

2. Present their pitch at the APC conference as a registered delegate

Pitch

If electing to pitch for Seed funding as part of a Lightning presentation submission, the Delegate must address the following criteria in the final 2 minutes of their presentation:

- Aim of the proposed seed-funded project
- Methodology
- Anticipated findings/contribution of the project and how it builds upon the work presented in the Lightning presentation
- Milestones for the project over 12-months
- Budget up to \$5,000, linked with Milestones

Please note: details about the proposal are not required for the abstract submission.

Deliverables

Successful applicants are expected to:

- Promote their successful grant on social media (Facebook, X, LinkedIn, Instagram) via their personal accounts and/or accounts managed by their affiliated institution.
- Deliver a report on the outcomes of the seed-funded project written using accessible language to be publicly available on the Psychosis Australia website.
